

How to Register for AMSA Alerts

AMSA has a alerting system that will send out critical alerts about issues and events concerning Assateague Island National Seashore or AMSA business. Such alerts would be:

- Beach closures or restrictions in OSV zone
- AMSA event info such a meeting reminders and deadlines for important events
- New Legislation that could impact Assateague
- Weather alerts that impact Assateague

Anyone can register to get alerts sent to their e-mail address or mobile phone as a text message. This is a FREE service offered by AMSA.

To register for alerts on the main page of www.keepersofthebeach.com go to “Sign up for Alerts”. Type in your e-mail address or text message address and you will signed up for any new alerts.

For mobile phone users (messages are limited by phone carrier of 120 characters, so some messages may be cut-off by the phone carrier). We will do our best to keep messages short or refer you to the website for something that needs more explanation.

To sign up your mobile phone here is the format you will need to enter you mobile phone’s address:

1. Verizon users – phonenumber@vtext.com **Example: 999563897@vtext.com**
2. AT&T users – [phonenumber @txt.att.net](mailto:phonenumber@txt.att.net)
3. Sprint users – phonenumber@messaging.sprintpcs.com
4. T-mobile – phonenumber@tmomail.net
5. Alltel – phonenumber@message.alltel.com
6. Virgin Mobile – phonenumber@vmobl.com
